# C. Academic Profile

#### 1. RESEARCH STATEMENTS

#### RESEARCH ENDEAVOURS.

I started my academic position in 2004. I am one of two researchers in North America with combined expertise in both dysphagia and clinical epidemiology. My most significant achievement has been my work on dysphagia in stroke, producing 1 copyright, 5 peerreviewed publications (3 of which are in high impact journals; and a combined citation of 190), 6 books, 2 book chapters, 40 invited talks of which 7 are keynotes. I have developed the Toronto Bedside Swallowing Screening Test (TOR-BSST©), a copyrighted dysphagia screening tool for stroke patients. The TOR-BSST© was tested on a large stroke sample (n=311) and has proven high reliability and validity. To date, it has been distributed to 205 clinicians in Canada, US, Europe, South America, and Asia. The Canadian Stroke Strategy (CSS) has selected the TOR-BSST© to be part of its CSS Best Practice Guidelines (2008) to be launched across Canada. In addition, I developed a new tool to measure medical outcomes of dysphagia (MOD) in patients with dysphagia secondary to stroke and head and neck cancer - the first tool for this purpose. To date, this work has produced 2 peer-reviewed publications (both in high impact journals), one paper in press and 3 in preparation. The psychometric validation of the MOD tool is a large focus of my current research activities. In summary, as principal investigator, I have obtained 18 grants totaling over \$2.4 million and given 82 invited talks/workshops.
