<u>SLP 1500Y –Internship - Recommended Course Schedule:</u>

The following schedule outlines minimum expectations concerning activities appropriate to the initial internship. In particular, it provides minimum expectations concerning a student's involvement in observation (General guideline IB), shared clinical practice (General guideline IIABC), and supervised clinical practice (General guidelines II ABC), within the total of **16-20 hours per week** recommended for such activities.

Students are required to complete assessment and treatment plans for all sessions that are reviewed by the clinical educator (CE) in addition, the CE should consider the use of regular journalling as a requirement for students to document their observations and progress.
